Duration: 2 min.  
Year of Composition: 2021

## Instrumentation

This version of *Canon Fanfare* is scored for 8-part flexible instrumentation. You will need at least one player on each of the 8-parts to successfully realize the piece. More than one player per part is preferred. Below are suggested part assignments:

<b>Soprano 1</b>	Flute Violin
<b>Soprano 2</b>	Flute Violin Oboe Clarinet
<b>Alto 1</b>	Clarinet Trumpet Flute Violin Oboe Alto Sax
<b>Alto 2</b>	Clarinet Trumpet Flute Violin Oboe Alto Sax Viola
<b>Tenor 1</b>	Horn in F Tenor Sax Trombone Euphonium Bassoon Bass Clarinet Baritone Sax Viola Cello
<b>Tenor 2</b>	Trombone Euphonium Bassoon Bass Clarinet Baritone Sax Cello
<b>Bass 1</b>	Trombone

What if I started off 2021 with a fanfare, a celebration of what is surely a hopeful year for many people? *Canon Fanfare* was born out of this desire. The work is essentially an A-B-A' form, with an opening fanfare section (mm. 1-18) a canon (mm. 18-44) and a closing fanfare (mm.45-end).
